

ACTIONS IDENTIFIED FOR SUPPORTING THE RESPONSE TO COVID-19

In Zimbabwe, Anglo American is working to identify additional actions to support communities in the response to COVID-19 during lockdown and beyond. We have committed to provide support for the COVID-19 response and will update our contributions regularly. Anglo American's contribution to the COVID-19 response in Zimbabwe includes:



Nutrition

Distribution of up to 3,000 food parcels over a three month period to communities around our operation in Zimbabwe. This will provide essential support to households during the three month period.



Health care support

Platinum Group Metals is aiming to support two clinics in and around our host communities.

Support may vary depending on government priorities and needs assessments, however the support will focus on:

- Covid screening stations
- · Medical PPE provision (Subject to availability)
- Training and clinician support
- The production of training videos for the broader community

~\$540k (USD) has been donated for the procurement to equip the Gweru Provincial Hospital ICU facility.



Community awareness and education support

Community Awareness and Education Support through the provision of information on local government and Anglo American support in local communities, health guidelines and the distribution of community recovery resources.



Water

Around our Unki operation 10 boreholes are being made available to supply local communities with fresh water.
