


CHILE

In Chile, we manage and operate two copper operation and one smelter; Los Bronces Mine, El Soldado Mine, and the Chagres Smelter (we have 50.1% interest in all three). We also have a 44% share in the Collahuasi Mine. Inspired by our purpose to re-imagine mining to improve people's lives, we are committed to ensuring beneficial co-existence with host communities and to working collaboratively with our suppliers, communities and partners. In striving to ensure that our host communities are sustainable beyond life-of-mine, we place an emphasis on progressively increasing our support to local SMEs and the employability of community members beyond mining.



ACTIONS IDENTIFIED FOR SUPPORTING THE RESPONSE TO COVID-19

In Chile, Anglo American is working to identify additional actions to support communities in the response to COVID-19 during lockdown and beyond. We have committed **\$5 million** to our COVID-19 response and will update our contributions regularly. Copper Chile's contribution to the COVID-19 response includes:



Nutrition

Distribution of up to 39,600 non- perishable food parcels over a three month period to communities around our operations in Chile. This will provide essential support to households during the three month period.



Health care support

Anglo American is aiming to support health centres in and around our host communities. Providing medical, sanitation suppliers and purchasing of medical equipment. Also including the support with:

- · Face masks
- Hand sanitisers
- Medical PPE
- Cleaning materials.



Community awareness and education support

Community Awareness and Education Support through the provision of information on local government and Anglo American support in local communities, health guidelines and the distribution of community recovery resources. Anglo American will also be providing support with internet data connection and the supply of mobile devices.

Providing support to small and mediumsized businesses through re-payment holidays and Training and Advice to restart business through our enterprise development programme Emerge.
